

# FR-8x Version 2.01 Changes & Improvements

This leaflet describes the enhancements made to the Roland FR-8x with Version 2.01 of its software. This leaflet is intended as a companion to the FR-8x Owner's Manual.

## Added Parameters and Values

### 13.5 Chin Function

Now you can assign the following functions to the chin switches.

Parameter	Value	Explanation
Chin 1-3	Accordion Button, Organ Button, Orch 2 Button, Orch 1 Button, Bass&Chord Btn, F.Bass Btn, OrchCh/FBas Btn, Orch Bass Btn	Assign the same operation as when the corresponding button on the main unit is pressed.

### 14.5 Function Switch

Now you can assign the following functions to the function switches.

Parameter	Value	Explanation
Switch 1-6	Accordion Button, Organ Button, Orch 2 Button, Orch 1 Button, Bass&Chord Btn, F.Bass Btn, OrchCh/FBas Btn, Orch Bass Btn	Assign the same operation as when the corresponding button on the main unit is pressed.




### 14.8 MIDI Foot Controller

Now you can assign the following functions to the MIDI foot controllers.

Parameter	Value	Explanation
Switch 1-15	Accordion Button, Organ Button, Orch 2 Button, Orch 1 Button, Bass&Chord Btn, F.Bass Btn, OrchCh/FBas Btn, Orch Bass Btn	Assign the same operation as when the corresponding button on the main unit is pressed.

### 9.2 Tone Control

The following values have been added.

Parameter	Value	Explanation
VOICING	Cycle 4-10	Cycle 4                      Cycle 5 
		Cycle 6                      Cycle 7                      Cycle 8 
		Cycle 9                                      Cycle 10 

### 7.1 Organ Selection

The following values have been added.

Parameter	Value	Explanation
VOLUME	Off, -40-Std+40	An offset value for the organ sound relative to the volume.

### Display Hints When Entering Characters

Hints for character entry are now displayed when entering characters, such as when you're assigning a name to a user program.



Parameter	Explanation
[UP][DOWN] buttons	Switch the keyboard mapping.
SET [◀] button	Deletes a character to the left of the cursor.
SET [▶] button	Deletes a character under the cursor.
Right hand registers [1] button	Inserts a character (Insert).
Right hand registers [2] button	Replaces a character (Replace).
Right hand registers [3] button	Moves the cursor left.
Right hand registers [4] button	Moves the cursor right.

### Jump to a User Program

When the user program list is displayed, you can now easily jump to a user program.

1. Select the user program list.
2. Hold down the SET [◀] or SET [▶] button until the "JUMP TO USER PROGRAM" popup window appears.
3. Press a right-hand register button to select a user program.
