How Do I Select Instruments in a Kit?

Any of the TD-9's drum kits can be customized, including instrument tuning, muffling, and cymbal type and size. Choosing your own instruments for a kit is a good place to start. You can select a different instrument for each of the pads within a drum kit. Here's how:

- 1 Press the KIT button so it's lit.
- 2 Turn the VALUE dial to select the kit you'd like to edit.
- 3 Press F1 (INST).
- 4 Strike the snare pad.
- 5 Turn the VALUE dial or use the + and buttons to select the instrument you want the pad to play.
- 6 Repeat Steps 4 and 5 for any other pads you want to set up.
- 7 When you're finished, press KIT—your new settings are stored automatically.

How Do I Use the Quick Record and Quick Play Features?

The Quick Record and Quick Play features allow you to record a drum performance using one of the TD-9 kits. Here's how to use them:

- 1 Press the QUICK REC button—the metronome click begins.
- 2 Turn the VALUE dial to set the desired tempo.
- When you're ready to record, start playing on the pads along with the metronome's rhythm. Recording starts automatically as soon as you hit one of the pads.
- 4 When you're finished recording, press the QUICK PLAY button. The new performance plays back automatically.

How Do I Optimize the TD-9 for My Playing Style?

To set up the TD-9 for the way you like to play, set the sensitivity for each of its pads. Use the following steps to adjust the sensitivity for a TD-9 pad:

- 1 Press the SETUP button.
- 2 Press F1 (TRIG).
- 3 Press F2 (BASIC).
- 4 Strike the pad you want to set up.
- 5 Press the + or button to increase or reduce the pad's sensitivity. Lower values require harder strikes to achieve full volume, while higher values allow you to reach full volume with softer strikes.
- 6 Repeat Steps 4 and 5 for the other pads.
- 7 Press the KIT button when you're finished.

How Do I Adjust the Hi-Hat Pedal Volume?

Here's how to adjust the hi-hat pedal volume in the TD-9:

- 1 Press F1 (INST).
- 2 Press F2 (MIXER).
- 3 Press F3 (KIT VOL).
- 4 Press the ▼ button to highlight "Pedal HH Volume."
- 5 Turn the VALUE dial to adjust the hi-hat level as desired.
- 6 Press EXIT when you're finished.

How Do I Use the Scope Feature?

The Scope feature allows you to see the notes of your performance as you're playing along with the metronome. This shows you if you're ahead of or behind the beat, and makes for a great timing exercise. Here's how to use Scope:

- 1 Press the KIT button so it's lit.
- 2 Press the SCOPE button so it's lit—the metronome click begins.
- 3 While holding down the SHIFT button, press CLICK•TEMPO to display the TEMPO screen.
- 4 Turn the VALUE dial to adjust the tempo as desired.
- 5 Press SCOPE.
- 6 Play along with the metronome and watch the display—each vertical dotted line represents a beat.
- 7 Press F2 (ZOOM +) as many times as you like to zoom in for a closer look. Press F3 (ZOOM +) to zoom back out.
 - When each pad strike lands exactly on a zoomed-in vertical line, you're playing in time.
- 8 Press KIT when you're finished using Scope.
